Were patients sufficiently homogeneous with respect to prognostic risk?	

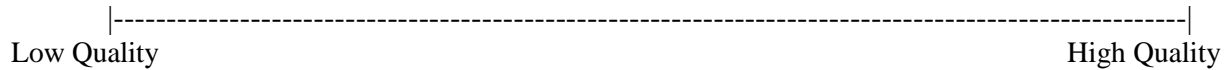
